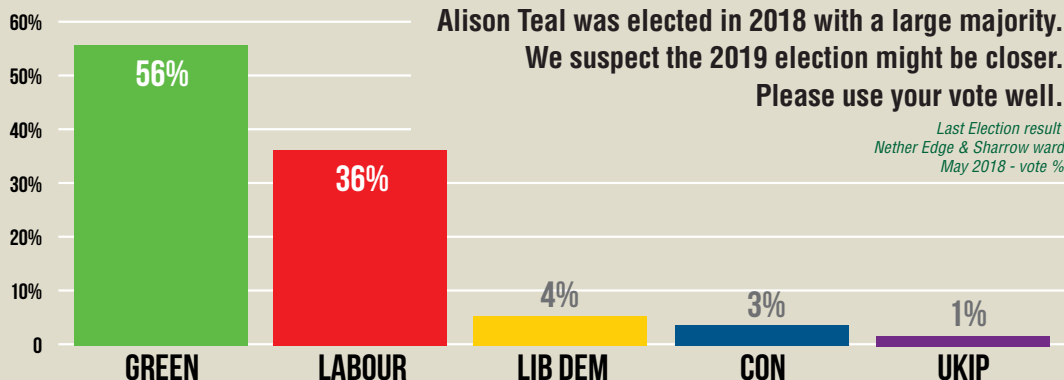
I would be honoured and excited if you were to elect me as your councillor on May 2nd.

A CARING CITY

VALUE FOR MONEY



GREENS opposed costly PFI contracts with big private multinational companies. We encourage local businesses - they keep money in the local economy.



The **LABOUR** Council spent £413,000 trying to jail peaceful street tree protesters. Thousands of healthy trees were felled that should have been saved.
