Douglas was elected as a councillor in 2016 and has been active in the community from Kelham Island to Highfield since then.

He has worked with Rob Murphy, and then Martin Phipps and Ruth Mersereau. Douglas also leads the group of eight Green councillors.

Douglas worked in social welfare, housing rights and discrimination law. One of his cases forced the Royal Bank of Scotland to install access for disabled people at its Church Street branch in the city centre.

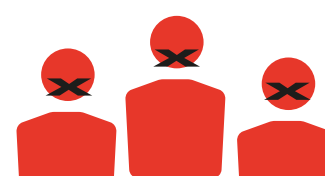

MAY 6TH

Douglas and your City Ward Green team have been working all year round helping local people with issues in their neighbourhood.



Greens have campaigned for less traffic in places people live and enjoy, such as **Kelham Island**.

We have liaised with the police over abuse from construction sites towards women.

Green councillors are supporting the community to make improvements in **Kelham Island**.



We've empowered residents in **Kelham Island** and City Centre to deal with service charges and supported campaigns on the Cladding Scandal.



Greens have consistently opposed demolition of independent shops on **Devonshire Street**.

We supported elite swimming clubs for the reopening of **Ponds Forge** and also pushed for community access.

We support charities, police and council workers dealing with begging & rough sleeping in the city centre.

Greens have been pushing for re-surfacing of new bus routes on **Rockingham Street** and **Carver Street**.



Green councillors support **Sheaf & Porter Rivers Trust** plans to open up waterways that flow through the city centre.



Your Green Ward councillors secured money from Government for new play equipment at **Duchess Road** in Highfield.

Councillor Douglas Johnson backed road safety work at a dangerous junction on **Bramall Lane**.

Green councillors took action to get fly-tipping and litter removed in **Highfield**.

LEADING ON CLIMATE ACTION

With Douglas' leadership, Green councillors have offered alternatives to how the city could be run.

Our budget proposals in March – which Labour councillors voted against – offered to fund staff to work on the **climate emergency**, **warmer homes** and **local, clean energy production**, plus a **£3 million fund**; an “**Electric FreeBee**,” the city centre free bus; more support for businesses; more jobs; and help for the poorest families, paid for out of existing funds.

Our planning proposals for a growing city would make the most of the city's waterways and require new city centre homes that are **big enough**, **warm enough** and **affordable to run**, so people have decent places to live and work.

SHEFFIELD'S PEOPLE REFERENDUM

On 6th May you can vote for change to elect more Green councillors.

But, there is also a referendum taking place where you can vote to **change how the council** is run. This is the Sheffield People's Referendum.

Currently the Council leader has the power to make nearly all decisions.

But, you can vote to change to a committee system – a fairer way for councillors of all parties to make decisions together for the benefit of Sheffield.
