Maroof has worked all year round alongside your Green councillors helping local people with issues in their neighbourhood:



Green councillors helped **Sheffield Tree Action Groups** achieve the successful realisation of a Sheffield Street Tree Strategy.

Supporting **Lansdowne Tenants & Residents Association** with housing issues, joining litter picks and helping community gardeners issues.



Campaigned against the loss of green space and trees at **Sheffield General Cemetery**.

Started the process of creating a Neighbourhood Plan for our area.

Involvement in the **Abbeydale Stakeholders Group** – set up as a community response to anti-social behaviour and working on a range of issues.

Your Green councillors volunteer to help with recycling of waste at **Sharrow Festival** at **Mount Pleasant Park**.

Helped set up **Kenwood Community Growers** – a community vegetable garden supplying vegetables to **Food Works** at **Sharrow Community Forum** for people in need.

Supporting **Mums United** – a community group of mostly British Pakistani mums finding ways to divert their sons away from drug gang involvement.

We helped establish, and volunteer with litter prevention community group – **Love Our Streets**.

Helped with funding and volunteering for **Family Voice**, a local charity supporting BAME women with language, life skills and more.

Your Green councillors helped residents apply for permission to run “Play Streets” on **Nether Edge Road** and **Wake Road** – and volunteered on the day.



Maroof has pushed for the **River Sheaf** to be cleared of rubbish close to **Broadfield Park**.

Volunteering and helping get funding for the **Nether Edge & Sharrow foodbank** at **Abbeydale Picture House**.



Pushing for resurfacing work to be completed on roads in **Nether Edge**.



Supporting the **Abbeydale Picture House** restoration project, including with funding bids.

CLIMATE ACTION - FOR REAL

Green councillors can be counted on to stand up for our environment. This isn't a campaign gimmick for us.

Green councillors have pushed the Labour-run council to take practical action to address the climate emergency.

We pushed for a clear commitment for Sheffield to be zero carbon by 2030 – not 2050 as proposed by Labour. In March, we submitted fully costed proposals to the annual budget meeting to ensure Sheffield does more to reach its target.

We called for solar panels on council housing, a new free electric city centre bus, plus more electric vehicle charging points and e-cargo bikes.

Our proposals were voted down by Labour.

SHEFFIELD PEOPLE'S REFERENDUM

On 6th May you can vote for change to elect more Green councillors.

But, there is also a referendum taking place where you can vote to **change how the council** is run. This is the Sheffield People's Referendum.

Currently the Council leader has the power to make nearly all decisions.

But, you can vote to change to a committee system – a fairer way for councillors of all parties to make decisions together for the benefit of Sheffield.
