We have all appreciated this important green space during the Covid-19 crisis and there is a lot to consider as the management plan is developed. **Tramlines** means a lot to the 40,000 people attending but a downside is limited access to the park for close to 3 weeks. Circuses and fairs also increase the parking impacts on side streets nearby. A balance needs to be struck between maintaining and enhancing the green space and future development and events.

The council are seeking **Green Flag** status for the park - a key aim is "To ensure that these spaces are appropriately managed and meet the needs of the communities that they serve."

GREEN COUNCILLOR ELECTED

Clir Christine Gilligan Kubo says: "Thank you for electing me as your local councillor in May. I'm working with local residents, businesses, community and tenants groups to support and improve our local area.

I'm also a member of the **Our Council Transitional Committee** tasked with implementing the referendum vote to restore the committee system in which all councillors

will be involved in decision making.

No party has an overall majority. The **Green and Labour parties are jointly running the Council in a co-operative agreement**. The Lib Dems walked away from negotiations but 3 seats remain open for them on the Executive.



Key priorities are to make the Council, and what it does, more accountable and visible and to address the climate and ecological emergency. I'm pleased that we quickly agreed to prioritise phasing out spraying dangerous glyphosate on our streets and pavements."
