412 people responded with lots of comments and suggestions - read the summary report here bit.ly/Hills21. The council will apply for **Green Flag** status soon.

The current work is "To improve the footpaths and drainage on the site before the next **Tramlines** in 2022, and to enable greater use of the green spaces for community use and for running, cycling, walking, and scooting which currently, can be restricted because of the poor drainage in the park." Aiming to provide "Increased event income, which will be invested back into the park".

Henry says: "Hillsborough Greens will continue to seek priority for maintaining daily access to the park for the health and wellbeing of local residents while minimising closure and restricted access due to Tramlines and other events."
