GREENS IN SHEFFIELD



Sheffield's Green group of 14 councillors

In the last few months the Green group have made significant progress in the council, working to make Sheffield fairer, safer and more sustainable.

We have:

- Passed a renewable energy motion committing the council to look into renewable energy installations on council owned buildings and new buildings.
- Passed an amendment on period poverty which focuses on the provision of free sanitary products in public buildings such libraries and community centres.
- Proposed a cost of living working group in the council. A package of support is now available to anyone in need and a network of Welcome Places has been created.
- Contributed to the Local Plan through cross-party work, Greens steered the council to publishing a draft local plan for new buildings for the next 15 years.
- Acted on clean air Greens
 have steered and supported the
 implementation of a Clean Air Zone,
 which has released millions of pounds
 in grants to support taxi drivers and
 small businesses.

SUPPORTING COMMUNITIES

There is funding available for community organisations in the ward. Last year, support was provided to projects in libraries, community

centres and neighbourhood groups.
