## STREET TREE INQUIRY

Green councillors secured an Independent Inquiry into the needless felling of healthy street trees. The report identifies "serious and sustained failure of strategic leadership" in the Labour administration at the time.

Greens were the only party that objected to outsourcing the work on Sheffield's streets and raised questions about the PFI contract.

If it wasn't for Greens securing the inquiry, the truth would not be exposed.

Cllr Maroof Raouf said "It is clear that a single party administration is not good for democracy as decisions are made behind closed doors. Many people in this area have been completely let down by Labour

We need Greens to make the council more transparent and open."
