## **MOUNT PLEASANT PARK**

People using Mount Pleasant Park in Sharrow said they would feel safer using the Multi Use Games Area (MUGA) if it was opened up. This work has now been completed and there is a clear sight line from the MUGA into the park and playground. This makes the space more useable for people of all ages. The park is also getting new LED lighting. The police, Sharrow School and Sharrow Forum all worked together to create a plan for improvements.

### New traffic lights have been installed on Wolseley Road to improve safety in the area.

In previous newsletters we informed the local community about these road improvements so that residents were aware of the work at the junction of Staveley Road and Wolseley Road.

Maroof said, "This is a residential area with lots of young families. The lights help to make a safer pedestrian environment by enhancing visibility, reducing conflicts with cyclists and vehicles, and ensuring pedestrians have sufficient time to safely navigate the crossing."

# **ARCHER LANE**

The decision by Labour and LibDem councillors to remove the safety measures on Archer Lane was met with disappointment from local residents who organised community gatherings at the Archer Lane, Brincliffe Edge Road junction. Many people are questioning why the decision was not based on statistics which show that there were decreases in traffic and increases in walking and cycling whilst the measures were in place.

Maroof said "The data showed that the measures were successful in offering people an alternative to driving and more children were able to walk or cycle to school safely. I'm very disappointed that the road is being used as a rat run again, but
