A campaign group has formed as a result of Royal Mail failing to deliver.

Group founder, Kate Billington explains "Save Our Post♥Save Our Posties has come about because local people realised they no longer had Royal Mail delivering to their streets! We worked out that many of the posties at the Woodseats

office have been made redundant, quit or are off with stress. As a result, lots of streets are not being properly covered and Royal Mail doesn't appear to have a proper plan to get our mail to us more than once or twice a week.

Posties themselves are not to blame for the chaos. It is due to poor decisions being made at head office level.

"Save Our Post♥Save Our Posties go to the Delivery Office every Thursday morning, 8.45-10am to protest against Royal Mail's brutal cuts and to show appreciation for our posties. Come and join us."
