Your Green Councillor Maroof Raouf has helped residents at **Lansdowne** and **Leverton**.

Lansdowne footpaths were blocked with flood water, mud and leaves. The paths have now been cleaned and reopened.

# **STREET TREES**

A local community group, Nether Edge and Sharrow Sustainable Transformation (NESST) is focused on improving the environment and biodiversity of the 1.8 square mile area it covers in Nether Edge, Sharrow, Sharrow Vale, Carter Knowle, Highfield and Lowfield.

NESST have coordinated funding to plant **186 additional street trees** over the last three winters. 75% of these trees are on roads with no street trees previously.

And there's more to come, **70 more** street trees will be planted on streets of **Highfield** and **Lowfield** before the end of March 2024, thanks to grant funding secured by NESST.
