Thanks to all who voted Green Party in the General Election this summer. **Green Party Candidate and ward councillor Angela Argenzio** received a **huge 26%** (up from 9%) of the total votes cast in Sheffield Central, putting us in a **strong second place**. *Well done Angela!*

PLANNING

Your Green Party councillors have supported residents against the McDonald's planning application 24/01129/FUL on **Ecclesall Rd**. Cllrs asked licensing for a cumulative impact report as there are too many fast food outlets in this area. This planning application has now been withdrawn.

Councillors objected to a planning application for an extra floor that would cause huge disturbance to residents at **Hunter Court** on Hunter House Road. This was refused by the planning department after resident and Green councillor pressure. Remember – your Green cllrs are here to help you on private and rented housing concerns as well as on social and council housing.

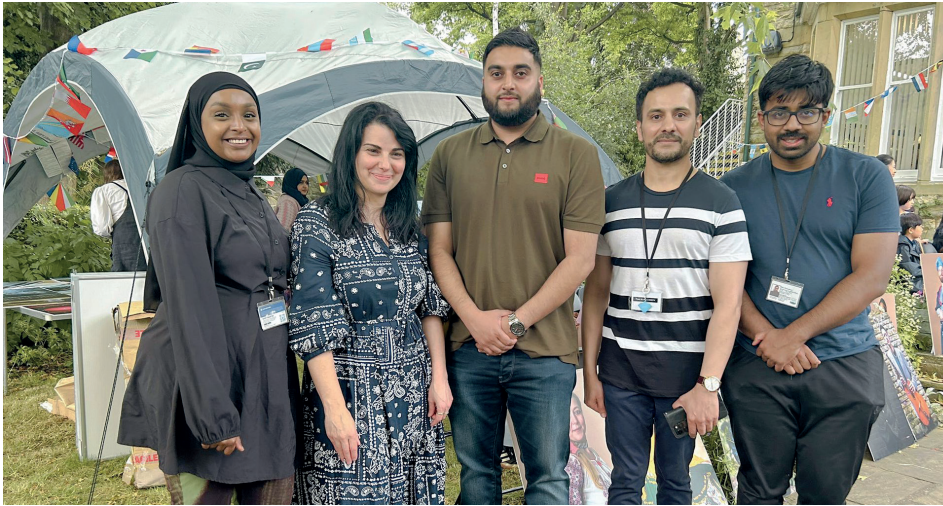
