Toby says: "The Sunday service through to **Wadsley**, **Wisewood and Loxley** returned on September 1st. Your councillors have kept on pushing the South Yorkshire Mayor to restore adequate services but the 2400 signature petition and local residents clamouring for improvements really helped make this happen.

I also kept pushing for a replacement bus shelter opposite **Hillsborough Exchange Shopping Centre**. It was removed due to subsidence issues but is now back, offering seating and weather protection for shoppers.
