

S6 FOODBANK - 5 YEARS

Hillsborough Greens started monthly street collections in April 2020 responding to urgent Covid needs, initially at **Hillsborough Corner**. Now outside **The Green Shop, Wadsley Lane**. During 2024 you donated 3072 kilos providing 7315 meals plus about £1500 cash.

S6 Foodbank recently moved to a bigger warehouse in Attercliffe and say: "Our aim is for everyone across Sheffield to have enough income to be able to feed their family and for us to be no longer needed. Until that day, we'll keep supporting people!"

TRAM TRACK MAINTENANCE

Councillor Toby Mallinson has raised the state of the tram track beds with the **South Yorkshire Mayor**, particularly on **Holme Lane**. **Toby** says: "The temporary tarmac patches don't last. The increasing numbers of potholes in the concrete are particularly hazardous for cyclists and pedestrians. We need repairs and maintenance that will last more than just a few weeks."




HILLSBOROUGH FORUM - GET INVOLVED!
