# MUSTAFA AHMED MAKING A DIFFERENCE

I came to Sheffield from Yemen in 2000 and live with my family on the Wensley estate. I work at Tesco on Savile St. I'm working to be your councillor, offering a clear alternative to Labour in the council elections on May 7th 2026:

**WENSLEY ESTATE** "I've actively participated in improving the quality of life for local residents for many years. **The Tenants and Residents Association (TARA)** work alongside **Sheffield City Council** and community groups to ensure residents' voices are heard and local priorities are met. I help the TARA connect residents with support networks such as housing

advice, health services and family assistance programmes.

'I had a major role in the **Wensley Park Restoration Project**, helping raise nearly **£40,000** to refurbish and improve the park's safety, play equipment, and green spaces. I help organise and lead community events including litter-picking days, children's activities and local awareness campaigns."

**SHEFFIELD GRAND MOSQUE** "I'm a volunteer and community support worker there and you will have seen me stewarding at events. I've helped deliver community programmes, youth activities and educational trips to strengthen community spirit.

'Too many politicians are trying to divide us. **Our mosques and churches are safe spaces** offering practical community support where people from diverse communities come together."

## FEE SABILILLAH FUNERAL SERVICES

"I'm practically involved in this new voluntary initiative offering free funeral support for residents in need. We provide emotional and admin support to bereaved families, guiding them through paperwork, communication, and Islamic procedures. We help co-ordinate logistics with local authorities, hospitals and cemeteries.

'Working under the guidance of the **Grand Mosque** funeral committee, we also assist with washing, shrouding, and janazah (prayer) preparations. **The service is funded by community donations and volunteer support - phone 07881 880721 or 07478 481427.**"
