Maleiki says: "Broomhill and Sharrow Vale is my home. It is where I was raised, went to primary school and had my first job. I still live here today."

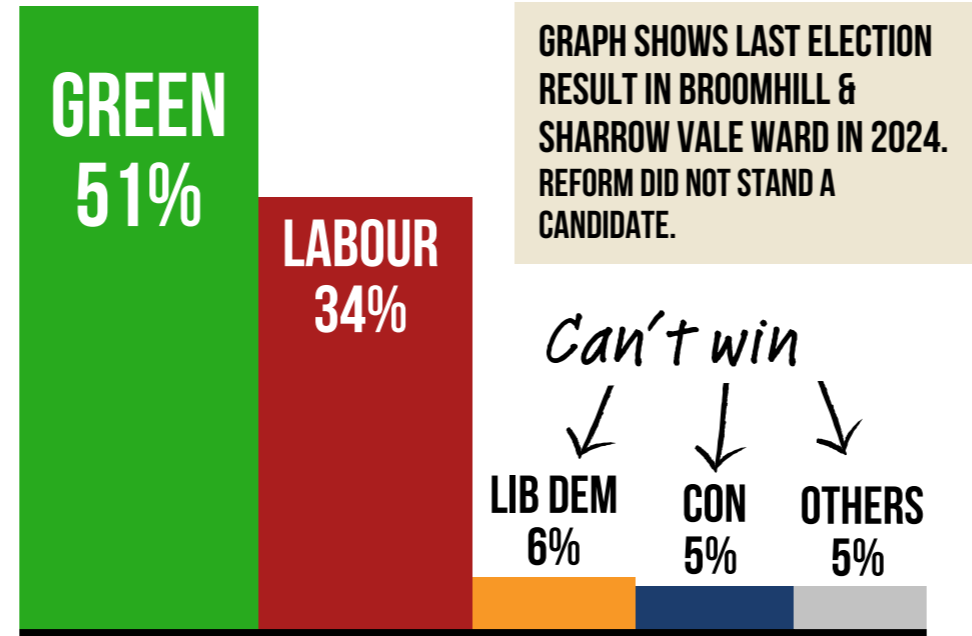
"Before becoming a councillor, I did community and youth work for many years. I care deeply about these matters, especially supporting young people and families with children who have disabilities or special educational needs."
