A lot has changed since the last local elections in Sheffield in May 2024. Reform did not stand in Fulwood ward.

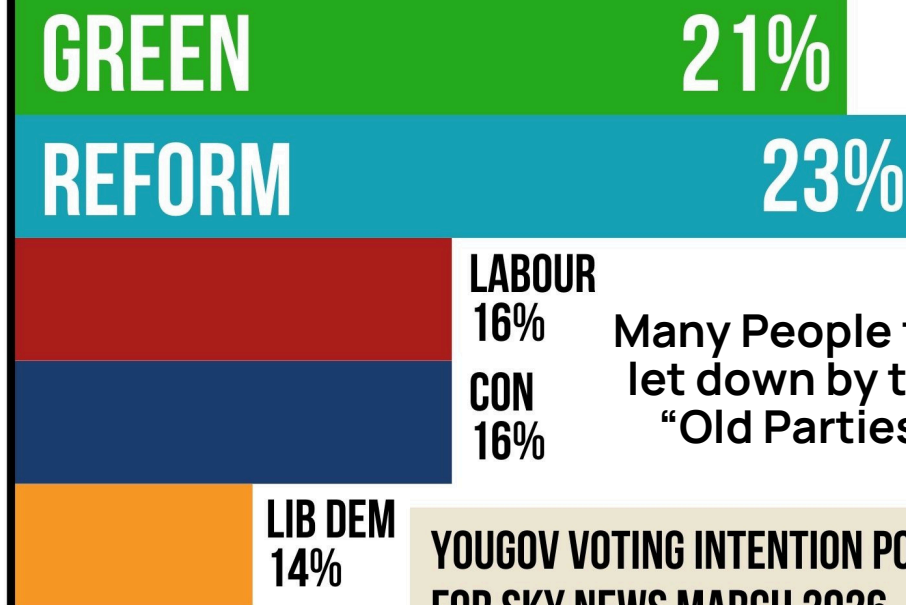
