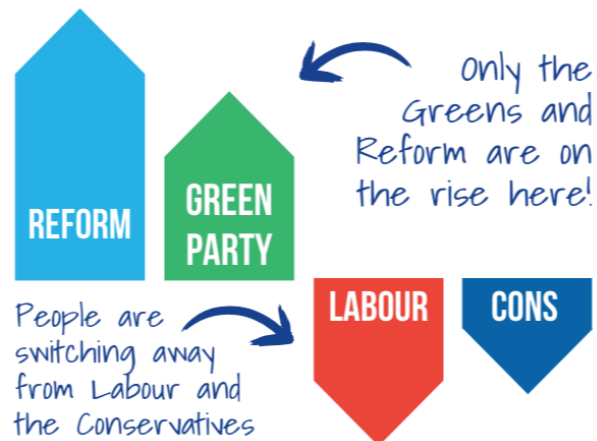

Cleared pavements and highways of leaves on Norfolk Road and Granville Road



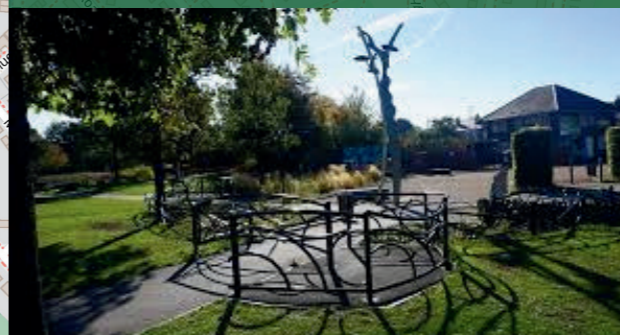
Ruth has worked with residents at Beaumont Mews to get contaminated bins reported and dealt with
